¹ **Daytime General Education Courses** are offered as part of the Post-Secondary Enrollment Option Program and are open to all UA students as well as high school students participating in PSEOP. ² The **Bachelor of Organizational Supervision** degree is a unique program, specifically designed for students who already have an associate's degree or have completed college courses totaling at least 60 credit hours. The program can be completed in as little as 2 years as a full-time student. Students should contact Nicole Lee at nlee1@uakron.edu with questions.

³ The **Bachelor of Social Work** degree at UA Lakewood is designed for transfer students who have completed an associate's degree. The program runs in a 4-semester cohort model, and is designed to provide a pathway into the MSW program also offered at UA Lakewood. ⁴ The **RN to BSN** option is designed for nurses who wish to obtain a baccalaureate degree in nursing. The program itself, after completion of the prerequisites, is three full-time semesters. A part-time option is available. The sequences are designed for RNs who completed either a diploma or associate degree nursing program as well as RNs with bachelor degrees in an area other than nursing. ⁵ The **Saturday MBA** program at UA Lakewood follows a cohort model. Classes begin each fall semester, and the application deadline is July 15. In the Saturday MBA, students take three courses per semester (7-9 credits) using hybrid in-class and online formats. Classes alternate between the Medina County University Center (MCUC), Wayne Campus, and University of Akron Lakewood. Students can travel to the other locations, or participate in their home campus classroom via distance learning technologies. Students can email SaturdayMBA@uakron.edu for more information.

⁶ The **Master's of Social Work** is a joint program with Cleveland State University. Classes begin each spring semester, and the application deadline is September 19. This full-time program meets two evenings a week for all four consecutive semesters. Students can email Becky Thomas, Lakewood Coordinator, at bthomas@uakron.edu for more information.

⁷ **Project ACHIEVE** is offered at UA through a grant from the U.S. Department of Education, and provides training for teachers that work with English language learners. Students can contact Diane Hergenrather, project coordinator, at dhergen@uakron.edu.
